Drawing on three decades of photographing, researching, walking, and building labyrinths, Cindy will lead you on a visual tour of Marin labyrinths. Explore both permanent and temporary labyrinths in schools, churches, open space, and private gardens. See the variety of construction materials: river stone, herbs, flowers, spray chalk, and beach sand. The workshop concludes with a walk of the mini-labyrinth in Cindy's Underground Gallery exhibit.



Discover why local interest in labyrinths has them popping up everywhere.


Understand the purpose of meander patterns and create a simple design.

Get advice on building a labyrinth in your space, and how to share it with your community.

Learn the history of labyrinths. Follow Ariadne's thread from the Minotaur's maze on ancient Crete through European medieval cathedrals and village greens to the modern international revival. Since Grace Cathedral's first painted canvas labyrinth walk in 1991, thousands of new labyrinths have appeared around the world. North of the Golden Gate Bridge, there have been over 50 in Marin County alone.

Fine art photographer **Cindy Pavlinac** focuses on the power of place, exploring sites of ancient wisdom and deep community.
